St. Andrews Garden Information - 2019

Watering

Water Access Location:

1. There are 2 exterior water faucets on the building. One is on the front wall to the right of the front door and the other is in the rear by the propane gas tank. The 'key' to the faucet cover and spigot is on top of the propane gas tank.

2. You can use the sprinkling can in the garden to get the water for the garden. Use the short hose stuck behind the propane tank to fill the sprinkling can.

3. Please bottom water all plants. This means watering at the base of the plant using the sprinkling can.

Frequency:

1. If it is hot and sunny with no rain for more than 2 days, the garden will need watered. If it continues to be hot and dry, water every day or at least every other day.

Weeding

Weeds can be kept under control if we do it on a continuous schedule. Once per week should be sufficient. When you see a weed, pull it or better yet, dig it out with a weed digger. The perimeter of the garden (fence) should be weeded as much as possible as it grows like crazy up between the fence. This area can be sprayed with a solution of water, Epson salts and white vinegar. Tom will hopefully take care of this task. ****** *This is an organic garden so we don't use any pesticides or herbicides such as Roundup.*

Distribution of Produce

When it's time to pick or pull some of the produce place in plastic bags, separating them by type. If you pick late in the week, you can take it to the Morgan Chapel (UM Church) on the corner of Woodbine Rd (Rt-94) and Gillis Falls Rd. **This food bank is only open on the** <u>2nd and 4th</u> **Saturdays of the month from 9AM to 11AM.** If you are unable to take it to Morgan Chapel or the timing is not right, bring it to church and we will take donations for a yet to be determined project.
